Floor cleaning agent Hako Cleanol SE

New: highly concentrated for streak-free shine

For use in automatic scrubber-driers, Hako has developed the cleaning agent Hako Cleanol SE for maintenance cleaning of hard floors and flexible floor coverings.

The concentrate effortlessly removes dirt and grease and, thanks to the lower dosage, has a high productivity and economy. Depending upon the degree of dirt the new Hako Cleanol SE has a dosage in the ratio 1:700 to 1:500 (1.4 to 2 ml per litre of water). This means that one 10-litre can is sufficient to clean around 140,000m<sup>2</sup> surface area thoroughly and economically – which corresponds to approximately 175 handball pitches. When using Hako Cleanol SE a considerable reduction in the storage capacity for cleaning agents can be achieved.

The synthetic, almost neutral Cleanol SE produces only very little foam and is therefore particularly suitable for use in automatic scrubber-driers. The concentrate has been developed especially for daily cleaning of water-resistant hard floors such as ceramic or natural stone surfaces – it can also be used on flexible, elastic floor coverings such as PVC or linoleum. As a result of its lime scale binding effect, Hako Cleanol SE does not leave behind any streaks after drying; the floor regains and retains its natural shine once more. The fresh smell of the cleaning agent underlines the cleanliness of the floor surfaces.

Any acrylic polymer coatings, which are found on the floors are not attacked or affected. Thus, even painted, varnished or metallic surface coatings can be cleaned using the concentrate. Naturally the cleaning agent can be used not only in cleaning machines but also for manual cleaning.
